

UNPREPARED PAINT

Warehouse **identification**,
floor **marking** and **safety** solutions.



Differences in warehouse and distribution facility budgets and their operational requirements, dictate the level of work allowed prior to applying a floor marking solution. This is why unprepared methods are often more appropriate than more durable alternatives.

Unprepared means the paint is applied directly to the surface, without prior work to improve adhesion. The performance of this floor marking method is limited but very effective. The paint can be removed, and layouts altered. They can be made more hardwearing later, once layouts become established.

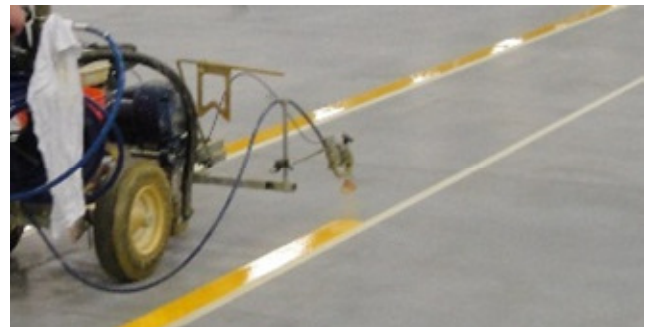

Even though this method of floor marking is on an 'unprepared' surface, we ensure the concrete surface is free from dirt, dust, and debris before applying the paint. We may request the customer to do this or offer to provide the service additionally. We will not start on an unsuccessful project.

We utilise airless spray systems and roller, to apply the paint in this process, other options are available and can be offered during the construction stage.
