Versatile configurations allow us to design and construct for almost any application. These included handrails on elevated sections, loading dock guards and on compactor gates.

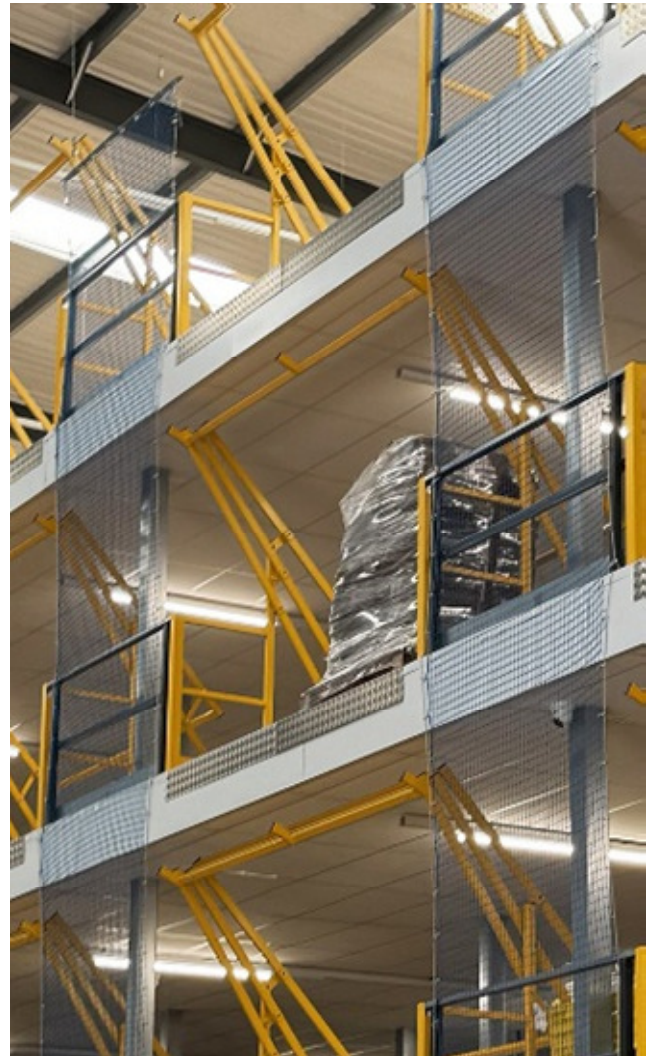
Assurance

Engineered to meet the demands of industry, our warehouse netting is the ideal solution for safeguarding personnel and machinery from falling objects. Whether you are managing high-volume inventory or safeguarding fragile items, our systems are built to perform.

Materials

Fortega's netting guards are produced using polypropylene mesh. The panels are carefully measured and produced to ensure flex and absorption strength remains in the system, containing loads up to 1000kg.

Steel components are purpose designed to form the support structure and offer stress retention in the event of an object impact.



RACK NETTING

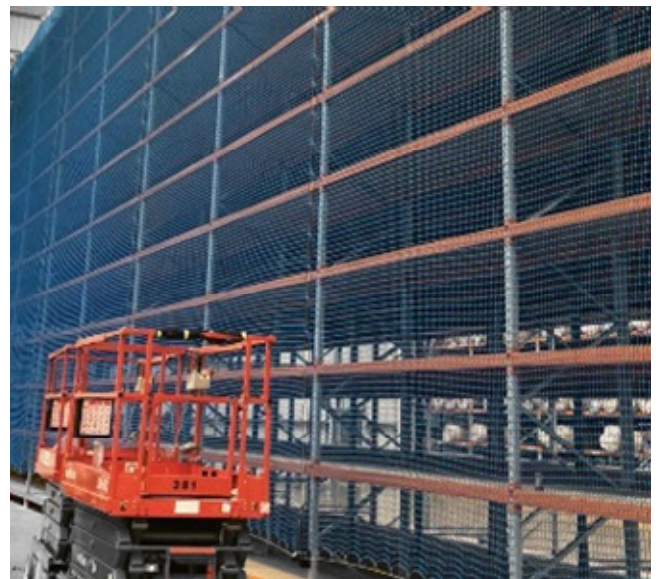
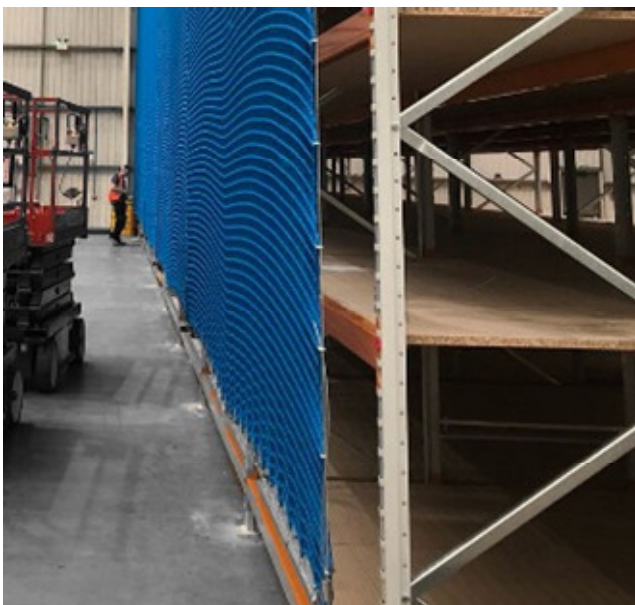

Rack nets attach to the back of pallet racking and act as a guard against falling objects. This is a necessity where walkways or working areas sit behind racking.

Our rack net systems are meticulously designed to offer exceptional durability, flexibility, and ease of use. Crafted with industrial-grade materials, they deliver reliable performance in demanding environments.



Advantages of Nets over Steel Mesh

There is reduced maintenance required of a net system compared with steel meshing. Steel requires replacement screens if the system is impacted.

The system is designed to contain pallets of up to 1,000kg to assist in a safer working environment and reduce the risk of falling debris causing a health and safety incident.

Installation of rack net systems are typically a third quicker than steel options. Once in place the system should require zero maintenance.

Materials

Fortega use a polypropylene net with standoff brackets, tensioned cables and hardware where needed to form highly retention guarding systems and less technical options for lower risk areas.

Netting systems range from a 2mm to 3mm gauge pending on the requirement needed. We can cater for various pocket sizes and are able to supply security netting for high value goods areas.

Colours

We are able to supply a range of colour options that will reassure your workforce with high contract colours, or that follow your company branding. Colour coding areas with netting can also help highlight risks.

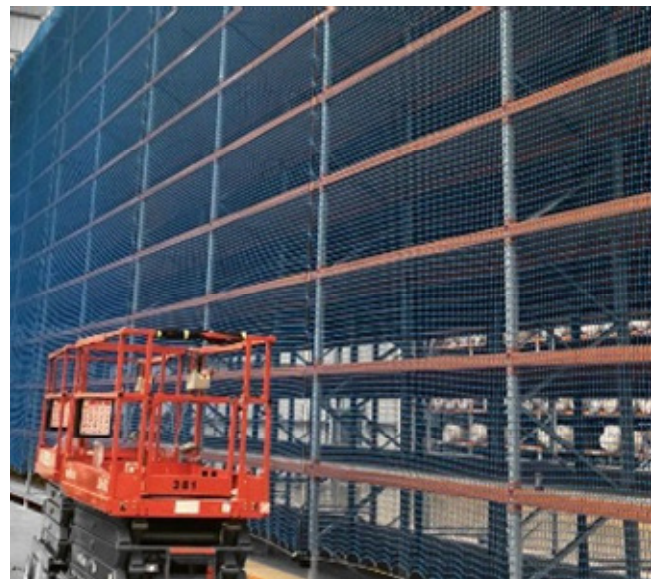
